VII. CONTEMPLATED EXECUTIVE SESSION

School district legal counsel will be present to confer with the Board of Education as requested by the Board

during the February 16, 2021, meeting. From time to time during the meeting, the Board may consider a motion to move to closed session to confer with legal counsel pursuant to Sec. 19.85(1)(g), Wis. Stat., concerning strategy to be adopted by the Board with respect to litigation in which it is or is likely to become involved, to wit, appeal of any decision regarding one or more of the detachment requests, and Sec. 19.85(1)(e), Wis. Stat., to conduct specified public business which for competitive or bargaining reasons requires a closed session, to wit, the division of assets and liabilities between the school districts in the event of the granting of one or more of the detachment petitions. The Board will reconvene in open session after any such closed session to resume deliberations and take such action regarding the petitions as it deems appropriate, and/or adjourn the special meeting.

VIII. BOARD DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION

The Board of Education will discuss and consider the petitions and may take action on one or more of the petitioners' detachment requests, including granting or denying the petitions for reorganization and issuing an order regarding the same.
